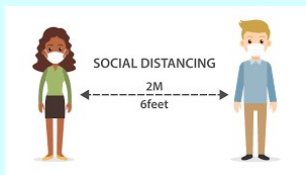
Phased Approach Re-Opening Timeline of Court Operations

PHASE THREE

November 16, 2020 – December 31, 2020

All services will continue virtually or by appointment only. Most proceedings will be held virtually. Health screenings will be required prior to entry to the courthouse. Only come to the courthouse if you have a scheduled appointment.

COVID-19 Visitor Screening Protocol

- ◆ Face masks/coverings are required in the courthouse at ALL TIMES!
***Your nose & mouth should NOT be exposed!**
- ◆ Temperature checks are required to enter
- ◆ Pre-screening questions will be required upon arrival
- ◆ No lingering in the halls
- ◆ You may be asked to wait outside



Phase Three Services

The following services will be offered by appointment only. Please schedule your appointment in advance:

- Obtaining information from the Clerk of the Court
 - Appointments with the Family Division Paralegal Unit
 - Legal advice from Community Legal Services
 - Appointments with the Trust Office
 - Obtaining transcripts or discs from the Court Reporters Office
- *All other offices of the courthouse - call ahead to schedule an appointment before arrival**



- ◆ Courtroom seating will be limited to social distancing capacity per courtroom
- ◆ The public is asked not to bring additional people when coming to the courthouse
- ◆ The Children's Waiting Room is closed. Try to make alternative arrangements for small children

Please review pre-screening questions below before coming to the courthouse. If you answer "Yes" to ANY of the below questions, please DO NOT COME. Call the courthouse to reschedule your matter.

In response to the outbreak of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) we ask all visitors to self-screen before entering the building, to help lessen the spread of the virus.

1. Have you had a fever within the last 24 hours?
2. Do you have a cough and shortness of breath or at least two of the following symptoms: fever, chills, shaking, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or loss of taste and smell?
3. Have you had contact with any possible source for the virus or person with COVID-19?

If you, or a member of your immediate household, have traveled outside of the Washington Metropolitan Area, and are not feeling well or are exhibiting symptoms, please STAY HOME!
